GREAT RESULTS FOR VISITING TEAMS TO THE TRI EQUESTRIAN INTERSCHOOLS SHOWJUMPING IN COILOG.

Despite the very bad weather forecast, Coilog Equestrian Centre in Kildare dawned bright and sunny on Sunday last for the 3rd leg of the TRI Equestrian Interschools Showjumping league. The Novice Team event was the first of the day and very well supported with 13 teams in attendance. 4 teams made it to the jump off with Scoil Mhuire Trim taking 1st place in a nail biting jump off with riders Grace Evans and Eve Killian jumping off for their team mates Lauren Brewer and Lucy McGovern in a combined time of 79.33 sec pushing the Newbridge College team of Hannah Lawler and Clare O’Ryan, John Flood and Robyn O’Donnell into 2nd place with their clear in a time of 88.37sec. Scoil Chrosti Ri, Portlaoise took 3rd place with St Mary’s Edenderry taking 4th place.

The Novice individuals was won in great style by Jamie Hargidan from Newbridge Educate Together on his pony Weydown Sunflower in a time of 31.59 sec with Ella Anderson from Loreto Foxrock taking second in a time of 32.20 sec.

The New EII 90 cms qualifier was introduced this year as a step up for the novice riders. The first 6 placed riders qualify for the final in April. This was won by Megan Larkin of Scoil Chonglas with her pony Lumcloan Max. Jessica Sheridan of Blessington Community School took 2nd place with her pony Sulis.

The Open Team competition was not heavily supported with just 9 teams in attendance. The St Gerard’s team of Claire Fisher, Harriet Bernon, Alanah Turner and Emma Ward were presented with the winning cup with the Newbridge College team of Max Ross, Leah Heffernan, Lucy Ross and Niamh Behan taking 2nd place. St Gerard’s had also won last week so now have 2 wins to start their season.

The tables were turned in the Individual competition with Newbridge College’s Max Ross taking 1st place on his pony Ballydavid Souz and Claire Fisher of St Gerard’s taking 2nd on her pony B Valerie. Both team and individual events are sponsored by TRI Equestrian with lots of vouchers being handed out to the winning teams.

The 1.10cms Class was sponsored by Horse Sport Ireland with 6 riders qualifying for the final in April. Rachel Grant on her pony Mo Chuishle Mo Chroi took 1st place for Colaiste Craobh Abhainn. Jessica Phelan from Dominican College Wicklow came 2nd on her pony Billy but also qualified her second horse Ludovick in 6th place.

It was so encouraging to see so many young riders in the Primary Teams competition. 4 teams made it to the jump off. Emily O’Brien rode for Kill National School and had the closest optimum time winning for her team mates Lucy McCarthy, Aoife Flynn and Sophie Flood. Clodagh Hendy was chosen as jump off rider for Scoil Diarmada, Castledermot and brought her school to 2nd place with her school mates Hannah Kelly, Aidibh Condren and Eimear White. A combined team of St Patrick’s National School Clane and Vallemount NS came 3th with Rathmore National School taking 4th.

The next leg of the TRI Equestrian Interschools League takes place in Warrington Equestrian Centre on Sunday 30th of September and is hosted by St Kieran’s College, Kilkenny.
