Equestrian Interschools Ireland would like to take this opportunity to note that your efforts have not gone unnoticed and that the committee is diligently working to provide updates and guidelines for the future, based upon the Roadmap for Reopening Ireland and Department of Health and Health Service Executive announcements.

Equestrian Interschools Ireland is developing guidelines and protocols based on the best research and advice available, to allow a return to activity, when restrictions allow activities to commence. The road to returning to activity will be long and each step will be carefully considered. The safety and well-being of our members and supporters will be paramount. The plan for the return to activity will be based on best advice available.
