Klara Ewings, a student from St. Vincents, Dundalk was the closest to the leader, taking 2nd place riding Major Ben in a time of 41.24. Sophie Roden, who is a student in The Teresian School took 4th place riding Churchmountain Primrose going clear in a time of 48.80 and 5th place was also filled by Dunshaughlin Community with Laura Reynolds and Smokey in a time of 51.74.

The Teresian School team, including Anna Corless and The Caherview Boy, Sophie Roden riding Churchmountain Primrose and Isobell Nally with Benny Liath were the only team to go clear on the day and the winners of the Novice Team event, taking home prizes of lovely rugs. Second place, on a score of 4 faults, went to a mixed team from Piper Hill College and Wesley College including Amy Byrne/Fine Tuned, Aine Byrne/Ziggy, Beth Maher/Blueberry Lad and Abbey O'Sullivan/Duchess .
