TRI EQUESTRIAN INTERSCHOOL SHOWJUMPING LEAGUE REPORT

The TRI Equestrian Interschools League Kicked off the first outing of the year at WEXFORD EQUESTRIAN in Tomhaggard where the skys were blue for the day in the south east!

Local Sponsors Bolgers Feeds and O Leary Insurance were responsible for most of the Prizes on the day which were greatly appreciated. These were supplemented by main league sponsor TRI Equestrian who offer vouchers to all placed teams in the Open league and Open Individual competitions throughout the full league calendar.

The indoor arena hosted the Novice teams and open team events , followed by the 1.10m League individuals . In the usual organised fashion at wexford equestrian the schedule ran to perfection with events kicking off at 10am and with just 6 novice teams to start the open competition started on time at 12 noon approx !

The open teams completion had a technical track rather than a high track catching a few teams out ending with faults after the two rounds were jumped . Only 4 teams ended with a zero team total and were drawn for jump off. Fifth and sixth place were decided on time for the lower placings but eventual winners St Kierans offered riders Ciaran Byrne & Jack Brennan were to face the jump off track and both riders gave super clear rounds in a combined time of 60.49, 2nd placed team Newbridge college black with riders Caragh Sweeney and Amy Carroll also pulled clear rounds but in a slightly slower jump off time of 62.05 combined. Third place team St gerards with riders Domonique Rooeny and Kirsti Connole jumping clear with 69.04 were placed ahead of the last team in the jump off Kilkenny whom riders Holly ryan and Lucy bolger had a fence down with a time of 68.51.

The 1.10m competition was a qualifier and the two phase competition saw Patrick Pearle with Outrath Kroontime win in a blistering time of 40.03 clear taking all the short cuts the course could allow.

Novice teams starting out for the year made a great start offering 2 teams to a jump off for first and second place Loreto Wexford and newbridge college with eventual winners loreto offering 2 clear rounds with Ciara Banville and Alannah Lacey finishing on a combined score of 76.43 pushing New Bridge college into second with a time of 87.44 with Lucy Ross and Niamh Behan being the riders taking the jump of challenge for the team. The minor placings were also jumped off with three teams on 4 faults to decide the third, fourth and fifth place. Lauren Wreck, Emily Roche for Presentation college wexford, Rose Mc Carthy and Huanner Mc Bride for the Colasite Brid and Loreto School and Charlie O Dwyer and Aoife Keane for Newbridge College Green with great excitement. Primary schools competitions are getting even more popular with 13 teams heading out to take on the challenge. The teams consist of primary schools made up of 2 riders jumping 55cm and 2 riders jumping 75cm on a team . They jump 2 rounds each and have a discount score to use from each round. Talent is obvious for all these up and comming riders with many offering super clear rounds to get their teams into the jump off stage . 75cm riders took to the arena first and set the pace for the little jockeys to follow in the 55cm section with one rider from each section representing the teams. The most exciting definitely being the later smaller section with Mammies and Daddies cheering on and encouraging these little riders. Eventual winners were the Kilkenny Mixed school , with Dunphea NS second and Tagoat / horsewood/crossabeg and Murrintown riders making up the third placed mixed team . Plenty of talent to watch for the future.

Next day out is the Sunday 6th November 2016 at wexford equestrian again with Pre entry for teams on the Wednesday Prior
