A very sharp cold morning in Killossery did not dampen the spirits of the Interschools Riders that took part in this leg of the interschools league. The indoor track built by Ciaran Glynn was up to height and quite technical which was a great test for the riders who are now 8 weeks into the league. In the Novice team competition only one team was on a clear score therefore there was no jump off. Newbridge College was the clear winner with their team of Aoife Keane, Kate Maloney, Sara Dempsey and Jodi Zebedee with St Ciaran's Kells and only three riders Eoghan Finegan, Paddy Finegan and Nadine Dunne taking 2nd. 3rd place was won by a new team to the league Mount Sackville with another team of three, Roisin Cormican, Jill McKenna and Aoibheann Keegan. The Novice Individuals was won by Jodi Zebedee of Newbridge with Kate Maloney of Newbridge taking 2nd.

The Open Team competition took place after lunch with the day getting even colder. 12 teams took part with four teams making it to the jump off. 2 Newbridge College teams, Mount Sackville and Borris Vocational School. The Newbridge College team of Caragh Sweeney, Leah Heffernan, Niamh Flinter and Max Ross took first place with riders Caragh Sweeney and Leah Heffernan riding the jump off in a combined time of 59.16 seconds.
