Inter Schools Show Jumping Competition Saturday the 17th of September 2016

Competition Rules, Regulations and Conditions

- 1. The competition is open to riders in <u>full-time second level</u> education in the school they are representing and who are under 19 years of age on the 01-01-16.
- 2. Schools may enter team(s) in descending order of choice (A, B etc.). In the case of excess entries, the number of teams allowed to compete shall be decided by ballot. Each entry must include the date of birth of each competitor, the school stamp and signature of the school principal.
- 3. A team may consist of 3 or 4 riders. Best three scores to count (as per Aga Khan nations cup competition). The competition shall be held under S.J.A.I rules.
- 4. There may be no more than one Grade A horse/pony per team.
- 5. A rider and horse/pony may jump exclusively for one school only and may not be entered on more than one team.
- 6. The Chef d'Equipe appointed by the school must be present with the team on arrival and during the competition. The Chef d'Equipe is responsible for the conduct of his/her team at all times and will be the only person allowed into the warm up arena for safety reasons.
- 7. Riders must be correctly attired and protective headgear must be worn at all times when mounted.
- 8. In the Open competition the height of fences in the first round will be from 85cm 90cm and in the second round from 90cm to 95cm. In the Novice competition the first round fences will be from 70cm 80cm and in the second round from 75cm 80cm. The courses will be built by Mr Alastair McGahern (SJI)
- 9. In the event of an equality of faults, the Chef d'Equipe will appoint two team members to jump off against the clock. The names of the schools involved will then be placed in a hat and an open draw will decide the order of jumping.
- 10. Prize winners must be mounted for the presentation of prizes.

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- 11. The course will be open for inspection on foot from 8.30am. The competition will commence at 9.30am sharp. There will also be a second course walk during the morning.
- 12. Any team that arrives late and misses their turn will have to wait until the end of the competition to jump.
- 13. No refund of entry fees will be made in the cases of entries which are not sent forward for competition, or which are disqualified from the competition for failure to comply with the rules and regulations.
