Students should note that they require permission from their Principal, chef d'equipe or school representative to become a member of Equestrian Interschools Ireland and that EII reserve the right to refuse membership. Becoming a member does not automatically entitle a student to a place on their school team or to compete as individuals as permission must continue to be sought from their school representative/chef d'equipe, to represent their school. A member can only compete on another school's team with permission from their own Principal/chef d'equipe and only if their own school can field a full 4 person team without them.
